Can you complete some of our home learning challenges in your learning journal at home?

Remember to share your successful challenges on Tapestry!

- Write an object for every letter of the alphabet.
- Play a game of would you rather...Would you rather be able to be invisible or able to fly? These can be adapted to anything!
- Ask an adult to take a picture of you washing your hands. Can you tell them what you did? Ask them to write down what you say. Reception challenge: Can you write some instructions as to how to wash our hands?
- If you had 3 wishes, what would they be? Tell your adult so that they can write them down.
- Make up your own story. Can you draw and label a picture to show what happens in your story? Tell a grown up your story. Reception challenge: Can you write your story?
- Can you teach your grown up some of the Makaton signs? If you would like to learn some new ones visit <https://wetalkmakaton.org/> for their Makaton sign of the week.
- Draw your favourite book character. Reception challenge: Can you write some words/sentences to describe the character?
- Talk to your grown about our recent Power of Reading books. Nursery- We're Going on a Bear Hunt. Can you make your own bear using different resources such as paint, play dough? Reception: The Naughty Bus. Can you make your own naughty bus using different resources such as paint,

junk modelling boxes? Take a picture and upload it to Tapestry.

- Make a shape picture using 2D shapes. Can you name the 2D shapes you have used?
- Look at different coins, can you name them? Ask a grown up to set up a little shop. Can you find the right coins to pay for different items?
- Watch number blocks at <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/shows/numberblocks>
- Go on a number hunt around your house? Can you take pictures of the numbers that you find? Can you write down the numbers that you find? Which is the largest?
- Follow a recipe and weigh the ingredients using scales.
- Collect data on your family member's favourite colours. Can you create a tally chart and show your results in a graph?
- Make some homemade number cards. Can you write the number on each card? Can you put the numbers in order?
- Find things that are taller and shorter than you around the house. Can you make a list?
- Build a tower using Lego or blocks. Can you count how many bricks you have used? What is the tallest tower you can make? Have a competition with an adult, who can make the tallest tower? Take a photo and add it to tapestry.
- Have a look at the webcams at Edinburgh zoo at <https://www.edinburghzoo.org.uk/webcams/panda-cam/> Can you tell your grown up what you can see? Can you draw/paint a picture of the animal? Reception Challenge: Can you find out some facts about the animal and write them on your picture?
- If you have a tub of playdough at home you can have your own Dough Disco, this is great for developing your child's

gross and fine motor skills to develop their early writing skills
