



Some things have changed... But lots of things are still the same!


Things that will still be the same!

- ✓ Almost all of the teachers are the same. (in fact we only have 1 new teacher!)
- ✓ Lots of staff will still be on the playground to meet and greet you in the mornings.
- ✓ Breakfast club and after school club will start from Monday 7th September - ask your parent/carer to get information on how to book this from our school office.
- ✓ Sports clubs will begin after school in September.
- ✓ We will still learn lots of fun things!
- ✓ We will still have lots of things to play with at playtime.
- ✓ The school rules are still the same.
- ✓ We still expect you to be kind, work hard and behave well.
- ✓ We still expect you to be in school for five days a



week!

- ✓ You still come to school in your normal uniform.
- ✓ You will spend most of your day with your classmates and see other friends in your year group at playtimes.
- ✓ You can still bring a water bottle but you must take it home **every night** to be washed at home and brought back with clean water for the next day.



Hey... we are getting you ready to come back to school very soon!



When you come back some things will be different...

You come straight into school between 8:40 – 8:55am .Which means you haven't got to stand outside in the cold... you come straight into class!



There will always be a grown up on your entrance door to greet you at these times. If it is after 8.55am the door will be closed and locked. You will need to go to the front of the school and see the office staff to let them know you have arrived safely at school and they can help get you to your classroom.

You will finish at slightly different times from normal.
You can be collected from school from 3.15-3.30pm by your normal grown up. This will mean there won't be a big



squash at the school gates.

Your grown ups will wait in the playground area nearest your class and a member of staff will send you into their care from the same door you normally use to come into the school building. Parents and carers will wait patiently (a bit like everyone queues up at the supermarket) as all the children are released, a few at a time. It won't be a big squash trying to get through the gates on the way out.

The desks will all be facing the front in all classes

So you can see your teacher easier and focus on your learning better and help stop germs spreading so easily..



Your class / year group will have one play area all to yourself This means you will have more space to play.

You will stay with your class for lessons, playtime and lunch
In your own class / year group bubble!





You will have your own dedicated space in the classroom that is just for you! That means Frank can't disturb you and Sheila can't borrow your stuff!

You will have your own pencil case/equipment that we will give you and you will keep it in school. This means you don't need to bring extra stuff to school.



Just like on an aeroplane or in a restaurant, we will bring your lunch to you!

You will eat this in your classroom with all of your classmates. If you are a home packed lunch then you will collect your packed lunch bag from your coat peg, where you will keep it safe.





You will have your playtime and lunchtimes with your teachers and your class.

Meaning you have lots of space to play and run!

Assemblies will be different as we are not allowed to have whole school assemblies at the moment. Assemblies will be in your class. You won't even need to do that long walk to the hall!



We'll ask you to clean your hands before you come in and lots of times during the day! So your hands will be sparkly clean and germ free!






You don't need to bring as much to school with you... just your book bag and a packed lunch in a bag if you don't have school meals.



You will wear your PE kit to school on your PE days.

This is so you don't have to get changed in school and bring extra clothes in from home. Please wear your black shorts and red T-shirt/polo top under your black jogging pants and black sweatshirt/zippy fleece (no hoodies). Wear your outside trainers and school coat too. Your teacher will tell you what days you need to do this. It will be the same every week all term.



We'll still ask you to try and stay two metres from others when you are outside class or not with your class group bubble- especially coming to and from school. That's in case you pop someone else's individual invisible bubble who isn't in your class or year group bubble! Or yours!
