Thank you for your questions that we have received about face coverings. We know lots of children and adults have wonderful face coverings, and we can't wait to see them!

We understand that there is different guidance for children of different ages....particularly between primary aged children and secondary aged children. We hope this information answers all of your questions.

1. Primary aged children are not expected to wear face coverings during the school day, including lessons or at playtimes . As a school and as part of the wider REAch2 Academy Trust we are following the DfE guidance that primary children should not wear them in the school : <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/face-coverings-in-education/face-coverings-in-education>
2. We would really appreciate it if all grown ups wore a mask when on site. Children are welcome to wear their face coverings too when coming to and from school with their grown ups.
3. Children will be asked to place their special face covering in their bag until home time; however if you could take the face covering home with you , that would be super helpful.
4. If children have face coverings in their bag they must not take them out and use them during the school day.
